Tackling ethical issues and dilemmas in community-based ...  
Ethical issues arise at each stage of community-based research and intervention. We divide community-based research and intervention into six stages: (1) selecting the setting in which to address the research problem, (2) designing the research or intervention to fit the setting, (3) recruiting subjects, (4) collecting data, (5) data handling, analysis, storage and ownership, and (6) disseminating findings.

Community-based Participatory Research: Ethical Challenges  
The Centre for Social Justice and Community Action has a particular interest in the ethical issues that arise in research that is community-based and participatory. Ethics relates to doing good and harm; how people are treated; and who benefits from research. In CBPR there may be particular questions about how to share power and resources, and create mutual respect, for example:
