These implications are radical and controversial. According to his later (sometime around 1953) remark, a lesser known or commented upon but arguably more important one: "That the Lord should play [dice], all right; but that He should gamble according to definite rules [i. e. , according to the rules of quantum mechanics, rather than 2 by merely throwing dice], that is beyond me."
